BOROUGH OF HAMBURG ORDINANCE NO. 04-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 98- CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM-OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG TO WAIVE FEES FOR IMPROVEMENTS UNDERTAKEN SOLELY TO PROMOTE ACCESSIBILITY BY DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough Of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 98 - Construction Codes, Uniform - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg is amended as follows:

- 1. Add new Section 98 4: Waiver of Fee for Construction to Promote Accessibility. No person shall be charged a construction permit fee for any construction, reconstruction, alteration or improvement designed and undertaken solely to promote use and/or accessibility by disabled persons to an existing private structure or any of the facilities contained therein.
- 2. If any provision of this ordinance is deemed or declared invalid for whatsoever reason by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
