## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG AMENDING CHAPTER 183-14 – REMOVAL REQUIRED; TIME REGULATED – TO CHANGE THE TIME SNOW AND ICE TO BE REMOVED FROM SIDEWALKS ORDINANCE #05-2024

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 183-14-Removal Required; Time Regulated – of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg is amended in its entirety as follows:

- 1. Section 183-44. The owner in actual possession or tenants occupying premises and lands abutting or bordering upon paved surfaces constructed of cement, brick, asphalt, stone or other hard macadamized surface material herein designated as sidewalks, along the public streets, avenues and highways of the borough shall remove or cause to be removed from the sidewalk in front of or bordering on their lands all snow and ice for a width of at least two feet along the sidewalks and shall cause all snow and ice to be removed from such sidewalks for openings from said sidewalks to the public streets, within 24 hours after same shall have formed or have fallen thereon.
- 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
