ORDINANCE NO. 04-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 203-VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC-OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE FRONT YARD OF RESIDENTIAL LOTS EXCEPT ON HARD SURFACES DESIGNED FOR PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 203-Vehicles and Traffic – of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg, is amended as follows:

New Section 203-5.2 Parking Prohibited on Front Lawns.
 No person shall park a motor vehicle as defined in N.J.S.A. 39-1-1 on the front yard of any residence except on asphalt or concrete surfaces; provided, however, gravel surfaces in use for parking at the time of the passage of this ordinance may continue to be used for parking but not expanded.

Front yard shall mean an area extending across the full width of a lot lying between the abutting street line and the nearest part of the residential building on the lot.

The terms of this ordinance shall not apply to qualified private communities as defined in NJSA 40: 67-23.2e

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
