Hamburg Recycling Program

**KEEP IT CLEAN –All recycling MUST be empty, clean and dry!
DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLING!**

The 4th Tuesday of every month – Bottles, Cans and Containers (No Styrofoam!)

Rinse out all containers!

- **Glass Jars & Bottles ONLY - All Colors** (No drinking glasses, window glass or lightbulbs!)
- **Plastic Containers #1, #2 and #5** Check recycle mark on container for #. Lids can stay on.
- **Tin, Steel & Aluminum Bakery & Beverage Containers –**



Avoid crushing or flattening aluminum cans

Must be placed in a reusable container.

The 4th Wednesday of every month is paper/cardboard. (No Styrofoam!)

- **Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail** must be bound in one-foot stacks and cross tied or placed in reusable containers not to exceed 75 lbs.
- **Corrugated Cardboard** must be empty, flattened and cross tied
- **Shredded paper** can be placed in a reusable, easy to empty container.
- **Cartons** - milk or juice cartons - coated cardboard/paper mixed with plastic

PLEASE: DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLING!

- Keep trash out of recycling
- Do Not put more than 75 lbs. in a single container
- **Light bulbs, Window glass, Batteries, Diapers, Styrofoam, Caps and Lids are garbage!**
- Do Not Mix Co-mingled and paper recyclables

IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW GUIDELINES - YOUR RECYCLING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!

- Recycling should be put out by 5:00 A.M. the day of pick up.
- If recycling pick-up falls on a Holiday have the recycling out by 3:00 A.M. the following day.
- In the event of severe weather, the day of pick up, recycling will be the next business day.

Residents may deposit sorted recyclables free of charge at the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCUMA) Recycling Center located on State Highway 94 in Lafayette Township.
