



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Quarry Road Pump Station, located in the Borough of Hamburg, with an awarded contract cost of \$648,000, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project involves the necessary cleaning and maintenance of the existing wet well, as well as upgrades of mechanical and electrical equipment. This work will support water quality benefits to residents and businesses in the Borough of Hamburg.
