For the safety of your pet and others please remember to keep your dog on a leash when not indoors or contained in a fenced in yard.

Per Ordinance 70-12 Section B. "No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog shall suffer or permit it to be upon the public or private streets or in any public place of the Borough of Hamburg unless such dog is accompanied by a person over the age of 12 years and is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six feet long."

Remember to check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors regularly and plan an escape route with your family in case of a fire or emergency.

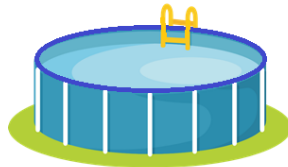

## Residential Pool Requirements –

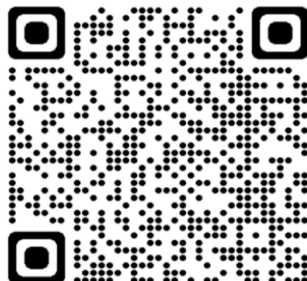

## SMART 9-1-1

Get alerted about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for our Emergency Alert Program. This system enables us to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as severe weather, unexpected road closures, missing persons and evacuations of buildings or neighborhoods. You will receive time-sensitive messages wherever you specify, such as your home, mobile or business phones, email address, text messages and more. You pick where, you pick how. During the summer months the Road Department will only pick up **grass clippings**. Pickup is on Fridays only. Bags must be curbside by 7 A.M. We make one trip through town each day. Bags placed curbside after the truck has passed will remain until the next pickup date. Do not put bags in the gutter or road. Rain can make them break open and clog storm drains and lines. Bags found containing any rocks, dirt, dog waste or household garbage will not be picked up.

We also ask that all homeowners please refrain from blowing cut grass into public streets. It's important to keep the storm drains clear of debris.
