## **Pet Licensing**

All Dogs and Cats, over 6 months old, residing in the Borough of Hamburg must be licensed yearly. Renewal notices are sent in December and the Borough will begin issuing 2025 licenses on January 2<sup>nd.</sup> Please license promptly. Late Fees begin February 1st!

Pets must have a valid rabies vaccination to be licensed. Per State Statute 4:19-15.a The current rabies vaccination must be valid for ten full months of the licensing year and therefore cannot expire before November 1st of the licensing year.

License Fees: \$16 for spayed/neutered animals (you must provide proof for new licenses) and \$19 for pets not

spayed/neutered. For more information contact Animal Licensing at 973-827-9230.

### Water News

The Borough is now using a new software for Utility and Tax. The new software allows residents to view bills for their property online. You will still be able to make payments online through the new online payment system (WIPP) which is more user friendly. The new fee is \$1.95 for e-checks and 2.95% for debit/credit cards transactions. Beginning the new year bills will now arrive in a new easier to read format as well.

Please be aware, if you haven't had a new water meter installed you are now paying a fee of \$200 per quarter for non-compliance per Borough Ordinance #13-2024. Please call 973-827-9230 Ext. 4011 to schedule your meter installation. There is no cost to the homeowner for installation.

Community members may notice changes to local vehicle/pedestrian traffic on the following early dismissals : Dec. 20th, Jan. 17th, and Feb. 14th.





As of Dec. 1, 2024 the DPW will no longer pick up leaves and brush. Live Christmas trees and wreaths will be picked up throughout the month of January. Please make sure no ornaments, electrical wiring or metal is left on the trees or wreaths and

please do not put them in plastic bags. They will not be picked up if any of these items are present. All items must be placed curbside for pickup by 7AM. Absolutely no artificial trees and wreaths will be picked up. Last day for pick up is Wednesday, January 31, 2024.

When bad weather arrives, please remember: No vehicles are allowed to



park on any Borough roads when they are snow/ice covered. Make sure all vehicles are removed from roads to allow snow plows to keep roads open. Basketball nets must be removed from the road. The Borough will not be responsible for any damage for items left in roadways. (Ord. 183-14) Do not blow or plow snow back into the roadway, it is against the law and unsafe. (Ord 183-15). It is your responsibility to clear any sidewalks in front of your property of snow (Ord. 183-14).
