SANITATION REPORT

1. .Food Licensing inspections for Domino’s Pizza and Hamburg Liquors
2. Solid Waste complaint on Gingerbread Castle Road. Work was being done in old restaurant, verified that all proper permits were in place.
3. Garbage complaint – King Cole Road – Zoning Office was called in and took care of complaint.
4. Fairways at Wallkill – Approval was granted to open the pool. All permits and inspections completed.
5. Complaint was reported by a contractor doing work in a residence in Hamburg Village. Condo association had the work done and the contractor they called felt there were unsanitary conditions causing odors. Inspector advised that for it to be considered a nuisance it would have to be affecting others before the county could proceed, he has been playing phone tag with a neighbor to see if he would make a complaint and then the inspector could document the complaint and act. The state Housing code reads that the county can act if it affects others but residence can live in unsanitary conditions if they wish to.
6. Cravin Thai – a pre-operational inspection was performed by the County Health Department and Hardyston Township. There will be a follow up inspection next week and then they plan on opening.
