Engineer / Water Superintendent Report

Sewer flows - May 2022

Although there was over an inch of rain one day, it did not impact the flows; they remained basically average for the month. As always, John Perry will be keeping an eye on them.

CCR Report

John submitted the CCR report to the State. It is on our website and a notice is on our water bills that residents can find it there. He also relayed he added extra information on the report because residents may find it interesting to know and it is paperless so he could add the extra info.

Limekiln Generator

The generator is being built.

Well #1A

John stated the numbers came back good – the water is cloudy to start but then runs clear. The electrical components have to be redone and John Ruschke is working on it. The pumps for the well also need to be redone.

SCADA System

John stated he will attempt emailing others in the company as no one has gotten back to him. He will try reaching out to Samsara and other contact reps there also.

Quarry Pump Station- repair to guide rails for lift station

The project has gone out to rebid with a new date of August 11th at 10 am.

Non-Compliance Notice

John received a Non-Compliance notice and has already sent the updated paperwork to the State.

Stormwater Management

Notice was received from the State that Hamburg was being reassigned from a Tier B to a Tier A for Stormwater Management. John will look at it and report back to the board his findings. He just received the notice on July 11th and there is a 6 month time frame to respond.

Installation of water meters update

Mike Schneider stated that there have been some issues with the batteries and endpoints. Abouts 6-7 homes have meters that the batteries are going dead as they are trying to find a signal and exerting more energy than needed, therefore the endpoints cannot function properly. Right now everything is under warranty and being replaced so the Board instructs Mike to contact Schmidts Wholesale to make sure the warranty is in place and for how long.

Mike relayed there are approximately 100 meters left to install and residents are not calling to schedule an appointment. These residents are receiving the \$100.00 charge on their water bill as per Ordinance 3-2022 for not having the new meter installed. Members mention getting the Borough Attorney involved if needed.

Councilmember Haig brought to the Board's attention that Mike Schneider's last day is October 13th and he, along with Councilmember Burd, Mike Postorino will be meeting and discussing an action plan.
