

**Borough of Hamburg
Board of Public Works Meeting Minutes
October 15, 2025**

Call to Order/Statement of Certification: In accordance with the open Public Meeting Act, with regard to notices, the regularly scheduled meeting of the Hamburg Board of Public Works was hereby called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Ronald Garrett invites all those present to participate in the flag salute.

Roll call: Pat Berado, Chairman Garrett, John Haig, Mayor Krasnomowitz, Paul Marino, John Moeckel, John Perry, Alec Yanish, Danielle Sena, and Paul Ferriero, PE of Boswell Engineering were in attendance. Regina Flammer was not in attendance.

Minutes: A motion is made by Moeckel, second by Marino to approve the minutes of the September 15, 2025 regular meeting. Chairman Garrett abstains from the vote.

Individual Cases: Danielle Sena and Alec Yanish discuss the water/sewer billing for the property located at 62 King Cole Road. Yanish specified looking into a cellular endpoint to receive a more accurate reading on the 2-inch meter.

A motion is made at 7:04 p.m. by Marino, second by Moeckel with all others in favor to submit a proposal to the Mayor and Council for a cellular endpoint to be placed on the meter at 62 King Cole Road.

Old Business/New Business: Danielle Sena discusses the water turn off process. Sena gives a proposed turn-off date of November 5, 2025. A brief discussion takes place to determine a date to complete the water turn-off process due to any non-payment of bills. All board members are in favor of a water turn-off date of November 5, 2025.

Sena mentions the order was placed for the new water/sewer bills with added billing detail. Sena added the new bills will be used for the 2025 fourth quarter utility billing.

A motion is made at 7:11 p.m. by Marino, second by Berado to open the meeting to the Board professionals with all others in favor.

Engineer/Water Superintendent Report: John Perry discusses the SCMUA flows report for the months of July and August in addition to the September 2025 Well Reports. Perry explains there were no issues with the Wells.

Alec Yanish explains he received quotes from Wind River and TAM for "pump station cleaning & disposal." After discussion, Yanish recommends using the quote received from TAM.

Perry briefly mentions we are continuing to receive responses back concerning the Waterline Material Identification Survey. Perry estimates we have received responses from 75% of the properties within the Borough.

A motion is made at 7:15 p.m. by Marino, second by Moeckel, with all others in favor of submitting the quote from TAM to the Mayor and Council.

Public Portion: No public is present at the meeting.

Adjourn: At 7:17 p.m., a motion is made to adjourn by Marino, second by Berado with all others in favor.
