

**Borough of Hamburg  
Board of Public Works Meeting Minutes  
November 12, 2025**

**Call to Order/Statement of Certification:** In accordance with the open Public Meeting Act, with regard to notices, the regularly scheduled meeting of the Hamburg Board of Public Works was hereby called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Vice Chairman Marino invited all those present to participate in the flag salute.

**Roll call:** Patricia Berado, Mayor Krasnomowitz, Paul Marino and John Moeckel. John Perry, Danielle Sena and Alec Yanish were in attendance. Chairman Garrett and John Haig were not attendance.

**Minutes:** A motion is made by Berado, second by Moeckel to approve the minutes of the October 15, 2025 meeting with all others members in favor.

**Individual Cases:** 11 Linwood Avenue. Sena indicates that the property owner is contesting the charge for the turn off. The mailing address was the issue. The notice was sent to her last mailing address at 44 Village Drive. Property owner was asked to attend and is not in attendance. Discussion on the mailing address. This property owner does typically pay on time.

A motion is made by Moeckel, second by Berado to recommend to the Council that the fee be waived for 11 Linwood Avenue with all others in favor.

A motion is made by Berado, second by Moeckel with all others in favor to open the meeting to the Board professionals.

**Old Business/New Business:** Yanish discusses the 59 water turnoffs with 5 are still off on occupied residences. Discussion on one residence that may not be occupied. One valve broke during a turn off.

Perry discusses the approval of the TAM quote. Yanish provides update that the stations were cleaned last week.

Sena discusses requests for contact information to be included with water billing. Email notifications could be sent for bill reminders but the actual bill would be sent by mail.

**Engineer/Water Superintendent Report:** Perry discusses SCMUA flow report for September. The flows have been low due to lack of rain.

Perry briefly discusses the line replacements. Property owners are handing in door hangers for the lead service lines. Several properties on Route 23 have galvanized lines.

Perry is waiting for the quote for Well 1A. He discusses the challenges due to changes in the company.

Sampling has been completed. He is waiting for the results from the UCMRS samples second round taken in September. Well 1A samples could be taken in the Spring.

A motion is made by Berado with all others in favor to close the meeting to the Board professionals.
