Boswell Engineering will need to inform the Board of the next steps.

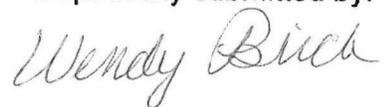
Perry informs the Board that Yanish has completed courses for water distribution and treatment and discusses the remaining coursework to be completed.
