

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Marino called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and opened with a salute to the flag.

**SPECIAL MEETING NOTICE:**

This Special Meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Law.

Notices of this meeting were faxed to the New Jersey Herald / Sunday Herald; Star Ledger on April 7, 2010. In addition, copies of notices were posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk on aforementioned date. Notices on the bulletin board have remained continuously posted.

**1. Interlocal Service Agreement – Hardyston Township**

Mayor Marino discussed that the bid contract for the waste pick-up for the Borough should have been advertised. He stated that budget plannings are in progress and this would be a burden on the taxpayers.

Motion by Councilman Law, seconded by Councilman Kelly to sign an Interlocal agreement with Hardyston Township for recycling at \$154,932.71 for a 5 year contract period, July 2010 to June 2015.

**DISCUSSION**

Council discussed the bulky waste pick for \$3500.00 a year, which covers man power and equipment.

Motion by Councilman Law, seconded by Councilman Kelly to include in the above motion the bulky waste pick-up for \$3500.00, with partial payment to be picked-up by the resident.

**DISCUSSION**

Councilman Krasnomowitz asked if there has been any new information since the meeting on April 5<sup>th</sup>. He stated that we do not know what the increase from Waste Management would have been and he still can not vote for the Interlocal with Hardyston without knowing what the numbers would

have been with Waste Management. Council discussed how much the last increase was with Waste Management - \$30,000.00 over the 5 years. Councilman Krasnomowitz asked about the \$3500.00 for the bulky waste pick-up and Councilman Law replied that it would be an amenity to the town but after discussion, decided it would be a service to the town. Motion by Councilman Law, seconded by Councilman Barr to withdraw the motion on the section for the bulky waste pick-up at this time due to budget constraints. All in favor.

Motion by Councilman Law, seconded by Councilman Kelly to sign an Interlocal agreement with Hardyston Township for recycling at \$154,932.71 for a 5 year contract period, July 2010 to June 2015.

Council members discuss the bulky waste pick-up and Council members Law, Barr, Krasnomowitz, Sena, and Kelly had already voiced that they would not be in favor of it. Councilwoman Oehler said she believed the seniors would benefit and if 100 residents would participate in it, it would cover the tipping fees. Council does not feel that it would not be enough to spend the money on at this time.

Phil Molnar – NJ Herald – asked if Waste Management had the contract before this.

Motion by Councilman Barr, seconded by Councilman Kelly to close to the public. All in favor.
