

**HAMBURG RECREATION COMMISSION

Summer Recreation

Joyce Oehler advises members any adult employee needs to be fingerprinted by the police department. Lisa Abrahams asked Joyce Oehler if the fire trucks would be able to attend Fridays that the program runs. Joyce advised the commission to write a letter to the fire department requesting the fire trucks. Chris Fitzpatrick was able to get five clinics to attend summer recreation. Members questioned running the program in the Pavilion as oppose to the new fields for the following reasons; pavilion is sheltered and has confined space as with the fields it is too open and not enough shelter in the event of rain. Summer recreation flyers are to be printed out and sent to the school by early May.

Motion by Ryan Kelly, seconded by Lisa Abrahams to hold summer recreation at the pavilion. All in favor.

Miss/Little Miss/Mr. Hamburg Contest

Members discussed getting 3 to 5 judges for the contest. Chris Fitzpatrick will look into getting volunteers. Applications for the contest should be handed out prior to school letting out for the summer.

Hamburg Day

Members discussed mailing and handing out Sponsor/Vendor Information packets to the local businesses. Members also discussed that no vendor should sell food or hand out beverages and see if the Hamburg Fire Department will sell food.

Chris Kelly opened a discussion regarding the selling/giving away the food. Last year at Hamburg Day fire department gave away food.

Tammy DeOliveria states the reason vendors are at Hamburg Day is to promote their business.

Chris Fitzpatrick agrees if the fire department is willing to make hamburgers and hot dogs have them do it.

Paula Marino states there should be no limit on what vendors can and cannot do.

Joyce Oehler will report to the fire department with questions regarding the cooking, selling, giving away of food.

Lisa Abrahams asks how she would go about ordering supplies for Hamburg Day. Melissa Morales advised to discuss further with the CFO Amy Maronpot.

Mark Sena advises Mayor and Council will be looking into picnic tables and soccer goals for the fields by summer time.

Motion by Chris Fitzpatrick, seconded by Ryan Kelly to close to the public. All in favor.
