Kathy said she emailed them for verification that it would be a "hands-on" truck and had not yet heard back. Ray Sikora is scheduled for the music and Ed Miller for EZ Bubbles. Real Amusements is all set to go. Paula discussed the issue of not having a rain date and the fact that the inflatables cannot go in the rain and how extremely fortunate we have been with the weather in past years. Paula discussed the fire department doing the hot dogs and giving out soda and water. Last year approximately 650 of the 800 hot dogs purchased were given out. The fire dept. will submit the receipts to Rec and then we will issue a check as we did last year. Kathy will ask Mike Schneider to check on the propane at the pavilion and also the nets for volleyball. She will also email the Police Director for their help with parking and police presence during the day. Road Dept. help will be needed but not as many personnel as last year as there are no tables or chairs to deal with. A notice to bring chairs will be put on the message board in front of the municipal building.
