Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report as prepared by Christine Licata showed a balance of \$14,783.47 without blankets. Motion by Chris Fitzpatrick, seconded by Sam Villagomez to accept the Treasurer's Report as given. All in favor.

OLD BUSINESS / NEW BUSINESS

Skylands Ice World

Chris presented a flyer for a clinic on "Learn to skate and Learn to play hockey" that will be held at Skylands Ice World. He said that it was also viewed by the Hamburg School and there were no objections as this is also going to be sent out through the school and needs to be approved.

Motion by Chris Fitzpatrick, seconded by Tara Scrittore to open the meeting to Annie Giannone and Patrick Choules from Skylands Ice World. All in favor.


