

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 53 - RECORDS -
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG
TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR DUPLICATION OF RECORDS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 53 - Records - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg to Establish Fees for Duplication of Records, is amended as follows:

Chapter 28-36 is hereby established and shall provide as follows:

1. The fees for providing copies of records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq.) shall be five (\$.05) cents per letter size page or smaller and seven (\$.07) cents per legal size page or larger. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the actual cost for duplication of a record shall exceed the foregoing rates, the charge shall be the cost of material and supplies, but not the cost of labor or overhead, associated with making the copy; and where applicable, a special service charge may be imposed as provided by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5 (c). Further, notwithstanding the foregoing, duplication of meeting compact disk: \$ 1.58; certified copy of vital statistics: \$5.00 per page.


2. Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with the provisions herein is hereby repealed.

3. This ordinance is deemed severable, and in the event any part hereof is deemed or declared invalid for whatsoever reason by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
