

**BOROUGH OF HAMBURG
ORDINANCE NO. 09-2012**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 183 -
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS - OF THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG TO PROHIBIT
THE CONSTRUCTION, PLACEMENT OR ERECTION
OF DEVICES, STRUCTURES OR EQUIPMENT FOR
RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES ON PUBLIC STREETS.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex and State of New Jersey that Chapter 183 - Streets and Sidewalks - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg, is amended as follows:

1. Article III - Recreational facilities in public right-of-way prohibited. Except as provided under the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:67-16.7, as amended and supplemented, which permits the temporary closing of streets for the provision of recreational facilities, no person shall construct, erect or maintain any device, structure, equipment or other thing in or within 10 feet of the edge of any street, road, lane, alley or other public thoroughfare in the Borough, the purpose of which is to encourage, facilitate or assist in the utilization of any such street, road, lane, alley or other public thoroughfare for any sport, athletic or other recreational activity which shall obstruct or have the potential effect of obstructing vehicular traffic.

2. If this Ordinance is deemed severable. If any section or part is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
