AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE PREPARATION AND EXECUTION OF A COMPLETE PROGRAM OF REVALUATION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR THE USE OF THE LOCAL ASSESSOR OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY

Ordinance # 07-2013

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 provides that a municipality may adopt an ordinance providing for a special emergency appropriation for the preparation and execution of a complete program of revaluation of real property for the use of the local assessor;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey (the "Borough") has determined to undertake the preparation and execution of a complete program of revaluation of real property for use of the local assessor; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of preparing and executing a complete program of revaluation of real property is \$250,000; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY as follows:

Section 1. A special emergency appropriation in the sum of \$250,000 is hereby authorized for the purpose of preparing and executing a complete program of revaluation of real property for use of the local assessor.


Section 2. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage as provided by law.


