

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 209 -
WATER - OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH
OF HAMBURG COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY INCREASING SERVICE
CHARGES FOR DELINQUENT WATER BILLS.

ORDINANCE # 01 – 2015

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 209 – WATER – of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg, is amended as follows:

2. Section 209-2 E (2) and subsections (a), (b), (c) & (d) thereof are amended to read in their entirety to provide as follows:

If bills are not paid within thirty (30) days after the due date for the respective quarter, the water supply shall be discontinued. The borough will furnish a minimum of ten (10) days written notice of a discontinuance of service. A service charge of \$100.00 shall be charged to the occupant if the outstanding bill, including interest, is not paid by the turnoff date specified in the notice of discontinuance. Water shall not be restored until and unless the outstanding bill, interest and service charges are paid. Water will not be turned on until the next business day following payment of the aforementioned charges, bill and interest.

2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
