

ORDINANCE # 02-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 44-23  
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH HAMBURG -  
CONTRACTED OFF-DUTY EMPLOYMENT -  
TO AMEND FEES AND COSTS FOR SERVICES  
OF OFF-DUTY POLICE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH  
OF HAMBURG

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 44-23 - Contracted Off-Duty Employment - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg is amended as follows:

Section 1. All references to Chief of Police are deleted and substituted by Police Director.

Section 2. Section 44-23 F (1) is amended to provide in its entirety as follows:

Rates of compensation for contracting off-duty law enforcement officers are hereby established as follows:


- (a) 2019 - \$ 80.00 per hour
- (b) 2020 - \$ 85.00 per hour
- (c) 2021 - \$ 90.00 per hour
- (d) 2022 - \$ 95.00 per hour

Severability. Should any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading of a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, held on January 7, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. and will be considered for a final passage at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held on Monday, February 4, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as same can be considered, in the Municipal building, 16 Wallkill Avenue, Hamburg, New Jersey at which time and place all persons interested therein or affected thereby will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning the same. A copy of said Ordinance is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk, Municipal Building, 16 Wallkill Avenue, Hamburg, New Jersey and is available for public inspection during regular business hours. During the week prior and up to the time of

public hearing, copies of said Ordinance will be available to the member of the general public who requests the same.
