

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, COUNTY OF SUSSEX,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 209 – WATER – OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG TO PROVIDE FOR A
SURCHARGE FOR REFUSAL OF ACCESS TO PREMISES FOR THE
PURPOSES OF INSPECTING, READING, REPAIRING, INSTALLING
METERS, PIPES AND FIXTURES**

ORDINANCE #03-2022

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg that Chapter 209 – Water – is amended to include new Chapter 209-8B (11) as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 209-8B (11)

A surcharge of \$100.00 shall be added to the quarterly bill for the consumption of metered water to any premises when the customer or occupant of the premises refuses to permit entry upon reasonable notice requesting access to the premises for the purposes of inspecting, reading, repairing, or installing meters, pipes and fixtures.

Section 2. This ordinance is deemed severable in the event any provision or part thereof is deemed invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading of a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, held on January 19, 2022 at 7 p.m. and will be considered for a final passage at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held on Monday, February 7, 2022 at 7 p.m. or as soon thereafter as same can be considered, in the Municipal building, 16 Wallkill Avenue, Hamburg, New Jersey at which time and place all persons interested therein or affected thereby will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning the same. During the week prior and up to the time of public hearing, copies of said Ordinance will be available to the member of the general public who request the same.
