

ORDINANCE NO. 05-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 203- VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC - OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY - TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS REGARDING PARKING DURING SNOW STORMS ON STREETS OR ROADWAYS IN QUALIFIED PRIVATE COMMUNITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 203- Vehicles and Traffic – of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg, is amended as follows:


1. Subsection A of Chapter 203-4 – Snow and Emergency Parking Regulation is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

Parking During Snow Storms. No person shall stop or park any automobile or other vehicle on or upon any public street or roadway or municipal parking lot or on or upon any street or roadway where the Borough provides snow plowing services to a Qualified Private Community pursuant to N.J.S.A.40:67-23.3 during a snow storm or when roads are snow-covered at any time; nor shall any person stop or park any automobile or other vehicle so as to interfere in anyway with the plowing and removal of snow from any public, street or roadway or municipal parking lot or street or roadway where the Borough provides snow plowing services to a Qualified Private Community pursuant to N.J.S.A.40:67-23.3.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

CERTIFICATION
