

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY ESTABLISHING A HOMETOWN HEROES BANNER PROGRAM
AND SETTING FEES**

ORDINANCE 04-2026

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg that a Hometown Heroes Banner Program and Scheduling of Fees is hereby set forth as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Hometown Heroes Banner Program to honor eligible veterans through the display of Hometown Heroes banners.

Section 2. Coordination and establishment of procedures, rules, regulations and eligibility criteria is set forth as follows: The Borough Council will coordinate and establish the procedures, rules, regulations and eligibility criteria for the Hometown Heroes Banner Program consistent with the stated goal of honoring and recognizing past and present members of the armed forces with significant connections to Hamburg.

Section 3. Sponsorship fee. The initial sponsorship fee is hereby set at \$125.00 per banner, which shall be charged to participating individuals or sponsors to cover the costs associated with the program, which fee may be amended annually, or from time to time as warranted, by resolution of the Mayor and Council.

Section 4. This ordinance is deemed severable in the event any provision or part thereof is deemed invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

CERTIFICATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the above ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading of a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, held on Monday, January 5, 2026 at 7 p.m. and will be considered for a final passage at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held on Monday, February 2, 2026 at 7 p.m. or as soon thereafter as same can be considered, in the Municipal Building, 16 Wallkill Avenue, Hamburg, New Jersey at which time and place all persons interested therein or affected thereby will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning the same. During the week prior and up to the time of public hearing, copies of said Ordinance will be available to the member of the general public who request the same.
