

**Borough of Hamburg
Board of Public Works Meeting Minutes
June 10, 2026**

Call to Order/ Flag Salute / Statement of Certification: In accordance with the open Public Meeting Act, with regard to notices, the regularly scheduled meeting of the Hamburg Board of Public Works was hereby called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Garrett invited all those present to participate in the flag salute.

Roll call: Pat Berado, John Haig, Russell Law, Vice Chair Paul Marino, John Moeckel, Chairman Ronald Garrett, Mayor Richard Krasnomowitz, Jennifer Valerius, and Paul Ferraro were in attendance.

Minutes: A motion is made by Moeckel, second by Marino to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2026 meeting with all other members in favor.

Chairman's Agenda:

Chairman Ronald Garrett states that a payment plan that was set up recently and suggested having a signed form document for the arrangement. Water Collector, Jennifer Valerius, states that a payment plan was created and documented. The same format for payment plans will be followed in the future.

Individual Cases:

Water Collector, Jennifer Valerius, states the resident with the payment plan did come in the day prior and signed the contract as well as making payment that was due. The property was also assessed a \$100 turn off fee as a result of the water being turned off.

Mrs. Valerius states late notices will be going out July 16th, 2026 and then shut offs will follow the first week of August. Valerius will coordinate with DPW Supervisor Alec Yanish on the date for shut offs.

Mrs. Valerius states that Springdale Village shall remain at the rate they are being charged for their EDU's. Engineer Paul Ferriero states the way it is set up is the way it is to remain.

Old Business/New Business:

Engineer/Water Superintendent Report:

A motion was made at 7:08 p.m. by Marino, seconded by Law with all others in favor to open to Engineer, Paul Ferriero.

Engineer Paul Ferriero states information pertaining to the grant information discussed at the prior meeting. He stated that main replacements can also be run under the contract as well in addition to the line replacements.

Vice Chair, Paul Marino requested to know how much each line would cost to estimate the cost and if a fee would apply to the residents at all to cover the cost of the project. The board requested more information pertaining to the grant as well as pushing out DPW to get the information from the 28 additional properties that need to answer the survey to get a clear picture of how many are needed exactly to be replaced.

BPW Liaison, John Haig suggested having a DPW worker stay after hours to assist on getting the 28 properties done.

A motion is made at 7:19 p.m. by Marino, seconded by Law to close to professionals with all in favor.
